2022 Scholarship Application for Spring Semester 2023

Purpose: In order to promote agricultural appraisal as a profession that is important to the economy and environment in Wisconsin and to advance the science of agriculture in general, the Wisconsin Chapter of the American Society of Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers (WC/ASFMRA) has established a scholarship program for students enrolled in agri-business management, land economics or real estate appraisal.

Amount of Scholarship: Up to three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for the Spring Semester 2023. Scholarship gives preference to UW-Madison, UW-Platteville and UW-River Falls College of Agriculture students.

Deadline for Application: January 1, 2023

Qualifications:

Eligible students must be currently enrolled as a **junior or senior** and must have an interest in farm management and/or rural real estate appraisal. Majors in agribusiness, farm management, agricultural economics, agricultural education, agricultural studies, crop and soil science, real estate and production agriculture are encouraged to apply.

This scholarship is based on merit and not on financial need.
